\$125 is added to the Save Now card on a quarterly basis—in January, April, July, and October. Any money left over at the end of the quarter will be removed. Covered rides to the grocery store, gym or other plan-approved locations are limited to a total of 140 one-way trips per year (distance cannot exceed 30 miles).
