What is the VA- PM&R Compensated Work Therapy Program?

Under **38 U.S.C.A.** § **1718, Compensated**Work Therapy provides for work assignments with community businesses as part of the VA's medical service—without creation of an employer/employee relationship!

Our goal is to enable honorably discharged veterans with disabilities who are in transition, to work and contribute to their communities and to society.

- Our Compensated Work Therapy Program is dedicated to assist veterans who want and are ready to work.
- Our clientele are honorably discharged veterans from all walks of life with a variety of skills and educational levels.
- We focus on the veterans abilities and desires to provide them the supports they need to be successful on a long term basis.

All veterans are medically cleared to participate and must remain under medical care as a requirement for participation.

How does CWT work?

- 1. We work with you to identify work activities that would contribute to your Company's mission while helping the Veteran meet his/her career goals.
- 2. We help with job analysis and development of a position description to describe desired duties & performance expectations.
- 3. <u>You</u> interview veterans and choose the best candidate (s) that most fit your business needs
- 4. You provide for the veteran's salary (CA minimum plus a small administrative fee).

Because we operate as a nonprofit, we can keeps costs to a minimum!

- 5. We provide a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), outlining individualized term-limits for participation (usually three to six months).
- 6. We request that you register, free of charge, in the Central Contractor Registration—the primary registrant database for the U.S. Federal Government (www.bpn.gov/CCR).
- 7. Every month, you pay the Department of Veteran Affairs (rate of pay plus administrative fee) for hours worked by the Veteran up to the agreed upon term limit.
- 8. Veteran is paid by the VA, every two weeks, only for hours worked. (There is no sick or vacation time.)

We offer, free of charge:

- ♦Follow-up training and ongoing support, Monday thru Friday, 7:30 am to 4:00 pm.
- ◆Professional Vocational Rehabilitation Specialists who will listen to your needs and make every effort to refer veterans with the appropriate skills and interests that match your business functions
- ♦Information regarding working with people with disabilities and addressing reasonable accommodations

Our program is accredited by CARF International—The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities.
